The South Atlantic District organizes a recruitment trip to WI in early March. The goal is to provide a fun, first hand experience of our ministry schools over an action-packed and extended weekend. The highlight of the trip is visiting Luther Preparatory School in Watertown, WI. The youth get a glimpse of campus life for a morning in (chapel, special presentation, interaction with students and other visiting youth, and more). Attendees can participate in a basketball tournament suitable for all ages and skill-levels. LPS also puts on their spring musical and a sacred concert that same weekend.

At the front end of the trip, we will tour Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary. The future pastors of our church body spend their last four years training here. The history and the impact of our Seminary leads all attendings for a greater appreciation for God's blessings in our church body. Morning chapel with all of the students and professors is an unforgettable experience.

Thanks to our district's youth fund and the encouragement of many others, the trip is partly subsidized. Every child receives \$150 and one parent \$100 towards their travel.

To encourage participation, LPS has graciously offered lodging to our group in the dorms and will cover all meals in the cafeteria while on the LPS campus.

In the past we have had anywhere from one to three teams from our district. If you are planning a trip as a school or if you are an individual family looking to connect, please do let us know.
